Sub.: Physical & Personality Assessment Test (PPAT) followed by Competitive Written Examination for 02 posts of Security Officer.

It is to inform to all the candidates who have been shortlisted for 02 posts of Security Officer vide Notice cited at Reference.2 that the **Physical & Personality Assessment Test (PPAT)** shall take place on 25th June, 2024 (Tuesday) followed by Competitive Written Examination to the candidates who qualify in the Physical Test (PPAT) on the same day (i.e. 25.06.2024).

Only the Candidates who qualify in the Physical & Personality Assessment Test (PPAT) will be allowed to appear for the Competitive Written Examination.

- There will be two papers in the Written Examination (Paper-I and Paper-II).
- Paper-I will be OMR Based Objective Type Multiple Choice Test whereas Paper-II will be subjective in nature. However, Paper-I is only qualifying in nature.
- The threshold marks for Paper-I shall be 30%.
- The Selection Committee will also fix a minimum threshold marks in Paper-II which shall not be less than 35%.
- The final merit list would be prepared based on the performance of the candidates in Paper-II. Only those names would appear in the merit list who have secured more than the minimum threshold marks as fixed by the Selection Committee.
- Medium of Exam-** The question papers will be set bilingually (in English and Hindi) and the examination can be taken either in English or Hindi medium.
- Standard of Exam- **Graduation Level.**

* This Test will be so devised so as to include General Intelligence, Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning, Problem Solving, Situational Judgment etc.

Note: The Paper-II will be evaluated only for those candidates who secure the minimum threshold marks in the Paper-I.

General Instructions:

- a) All eligible candidates have to download their **Admit Card** from the CSIR-CCMB web portal from **07.06.2024 from 05:00 PM to 24.06.2024 upto 11:59 PM**. The instructions to download the Admit Card will be available on CSIR-CCMB website shortly. Communication in this regard is also being sent to all the shortlisted candidates to their registered email address indicated in their application form.
- b) Admission to the Physical and Personality Assessment Test followed by Written Examination is provisional, if it is found at any point of time even after selection that the candidate does not fulfil any of the conditions of eligibility, his candidature will be summarily cancelled without any notice and no appeal against such cancellation will be entertained. The candidates are therefore, advised to check carefully and satisfy themselves that they fulfil all the conditions of eligibility for the post they have applied for. Mere appearing for tests does not confer any right on them for permanent appointment in CSIR-CCMB.
- c) The travel and stay arrangements have to be taken care by the candidates themselves. CSIR-CCMB will not bear any expenditure in this regard. Candidates are advised to stay in Hyderabad on 25.06.2024 till completion of the Physical and Personality Assessment test followed by Written Examination in case of any delay in completion of the test. However, efforts will be made to complete the Physical and Personality Assessment Test followed by Written Examination on the same day. Outstation candidates are informed to make necessary arrangements to reach Hyderabad well in advance preferably one day before the Physical Test (PPAT) for their convenience.
- d) In case of any injury during the Physical and Personality Assessment Test, the CSIR-CCMB will not bear any expenses towards the treatment of the same. However, First Aid facilities will be made available at the time of Physical and Personality Assessment Test. Candidates attending the Physical and Personality Assessment Test shall not be entitled to claim any compensation from CSIR-CCMB, for any injury / loss / mishap that may occur during their Physical and Personality Assessment Test.

- e) Any point not covered specifically in the above instructions, the decision of the Competent Authority, CSIR-CCMB, Hyderabad shall be final and binding on all candidates.
